

## Result: Assam Mathematics Olympiad 2021

The results of Assam Mathematics Olympiad (AMO) organised by Assam Academy of Mathematics held on September 26, 2021 are declared today, the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2021.

The competition was held online in two categories viz., Category II (classes VII - VIII) and Category III (classes IX, X & X appeared in 2021). Altogether 423 candidates appeared in both categories (185 in Category II and 238 in Category III).

Priyanjali Chatterjee of Pranabananda Vidya Mandir and Sunaina Pati of Sarala Birla Gyan Jyoti School topped the lists of successful candidates in Category II and Category III respectively.

3. Each of the rank holders in both categories will get a copy of Mathematics Olympiad related book offered by Mr Pankaj Agarwal who was a pass out of Jorhat Engineering College, Assam and presently working in a Delhi based reputed Institute.

All awards like Cash Prizes, books along with certificates will be awarded later with prior information to awardees concerned.
