**CLEANLINESS DRIVE PROGRAMME**

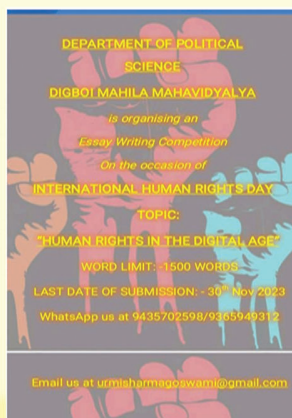
30/09/2023

20TH NOVEMBER TO 4TH DECEMBER,2023

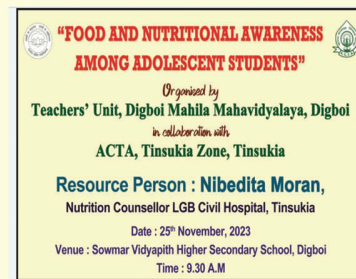

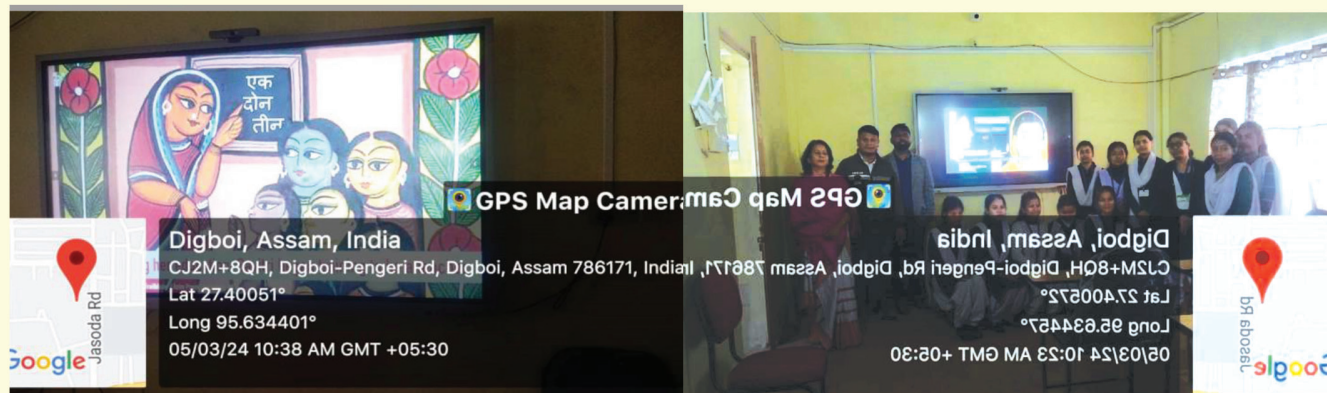

DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY ORGANISED A PROGRAM ON NARI VANDANA

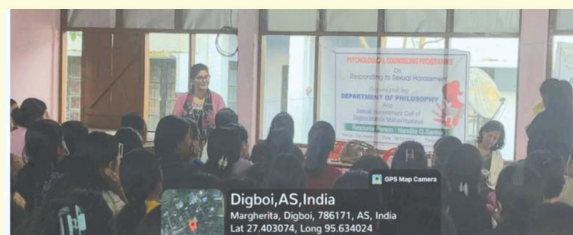
5th March, 2024

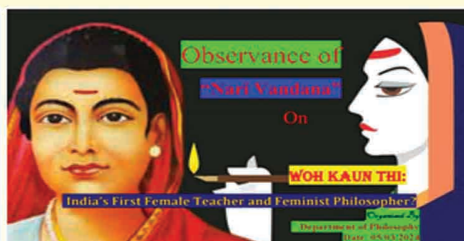

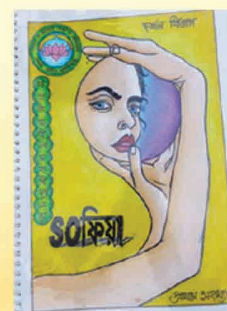
19th April, 2024

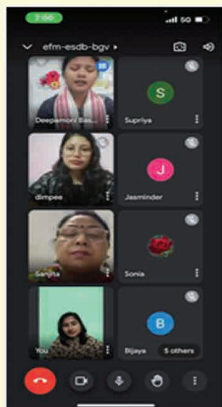
INAUGURATION OF HANDWRITTEN MAGAZINE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY
